

# Not Your Usual Day Trip: Elite Quick Excursions By Private Jet

The classic definition of a day trip is usually something along the lines of a short spin into the countryside for a city dweller, or deeper into the countryside for those outside of the city. For those looking for something a bit more unusual and farther away, [Schubach Aviation](#) has come up with a selection of day trips by private jet, [Elevated Excursions](#), with a fleet ranging from six passenger to 12 passenger jets if you want to bring some friends along.

The inspiration for the trips came from the collection of contacts the company has built up over the years. “We wanted to highlight how much you can do in a single day when flying private,” explains Kimberly Herrell, Schubach Aviation President. “With the relationships with other brands of a certain prestige, this has been a great way to collaborate with them and create exceptional one day experiences. Departures can be arranged from any U.S. city—to be a day trip, though, destinations should be no more than 800 miles or two hours flight time away. (If longer trips are requested, additional arrangements can be made.) Previous trips have included a day at the Concours d’Elegance at Pebble Beach. Upcoming trip suggestions include a day at [The Thermal Club](#) in Thermal, California for a spin around the track in a Lamborghini Aventador or Huracan guided by professional driving instructors, a trip to La Paz, Mexico organized by the travel company [Scott Dunn](#) to swim with sea lions and whale sharks in the Sea of Cortez and a private wine adventure in the Napa Valley in conjunction with the San Diego wine seller [Meritage Wine Market](#). But the company can customize other experiences and destinations.
